Subject: STATUS OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT AWARD FOR STATE HIGHWAY PROJECTS

SUMMARY:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) is presenting this Information Item to provide the status of construction contract award for projects on the State Highway System allocated in Fiscal Years 2022-23, and 2023-24.

In 2022-23, the California Transportation Commission (Commission) allocated \$3.78 billion to construct 488 State-Administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), and State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) projects on the State Highway System. As of May 20, 2024, 480 projects totaling \$4.44 billion have been awarded, one project has lapsed, and the Department plans to re-program its Construction phase, and seven projects have approved time extensions and should be awarded by their extended deadlines.

In 2023-24, the Commission allocated \$3.58 billion to construct 386 State-Administered STIP, and SHOPP projects on the State Highway System. As of May 20, 2024, 277 projects totaling \$2.53 billion have been awarded, two projects have lapsed, and the Department plans to re-program their Construction phase, one project has a concurrent time extension, 11 projects have approved time extensions, and the remaining 95 projects should be awarded by their original deadlines.

BACKGROUND:

In accordance with STIP and SHOPP Guidelines, projects are required to be ready to proceed to construction within six months of allocation.
