Subject: ALLOCATION AMENDMENT FOR A TRANSIT AND INTERCITY RAIL

CAPITAL PROGRAM COMPONENT

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation amendment for the Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program (TIRCP) (2018:17) Blue Line Rail Corridor Transit Enhancements (Blue Line Feeder Bus Service (11 buses) for Route 925) component (PPNO CP032), in San Diego County, to deallocate a combined total of \$305,000 from the Construction (CON) phase to reflect component savings?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation amendment for the TIRCP (2018:17) Blue Line Rail Corridor Transit Enhancements (Blue Line Feeder Bus Service (11 buses) for Route 925) component (PPNO CP032), in San Diego County, to deallocate a combined total of \$305,000 from the CON phase to reflect component savings as follows:

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BACKGROUND:

In June 2021, the Commission approved \$13,316,000 for the CON phase of the TIRCP (2018:17) Blue Line Rail Corridor Transit Enhancements (Blue Line Feeder Bus Service (11 buses) for Route 925) component (PPNO CP032), under Resolution TIRCP-2021-30. In June 2023, the Commission approved \$66,000 in supplemental funds, under Resolution TIRCP-2223-90S.

The San Diego Metropolitan Transit System (SDMTS) submitted a lower final invoice amount than the total allocated amount for the component. The lower billed amount was due to a credit received from the Hybrid and Zero-Emission Truck and Bus Voucher Incentive Program that was applied to the battery electric buses order. The credit went directly to the bus manufacturer and was treated as a reduction in the invoice cost rather than additional revenue, resulting in cost savings. SDMTS is proposing to redirect the \$305,000 in cost savings from the Blue Line Feeder Bus Service (11 buses) for Route 925 component (PPNO CP032) concurrently to the CON phase of the Blue Line Feeder Bus Service Charging Infrastructure for Route 925 component.

The changes are reflected in strikethrough and bold in the attached revised vote boxes.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Be it resolved, that the TIRCP (2018:17) Blue Line Rail Corridor Transit Enhancements (Blue Line Feeder Bus Service (11 buses) for Route 925) component (PPNO CP032), is hereby amended to deallocate a combined total of \$305,000 from the CON phase, in accordance with the attached revised vote boxes.
