Subject: ALLOCATION AMENDMENT FOR A TRANSIT AND INTERCITY RAIL CAPITAL

**PROGRAM COMPONENT** 

## **ISSUE:**

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation amendment for the Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program (TIRCP) (2018:19) Valley Rail (Old North Sacramento Station) component (PPNO CP035O), in Sacramento County, to rescind a combined total of \$1,073,000 from the Right of Way (RW) and Plans, Specifications, and Estimate (PS&E) phases due to the allocations being requested earlier than anticipated?

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation amendment for the TIRCP (2018:19) Valley Rail (Old North Sacramento Station) component (PPNO CP035O), in Sacramento County, to rescind a combined total of \$1,073,000 from the RW and PS&E phases due to the allocations being requested earlier than anticipated, as follows:

# CHAIR AND COMMISSIONERS CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

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## **BACKGROUND:**

In January 2021, the Commission approved \$9,599,000 for the RW phase of the (2018:19) Valley Rail (Acquisition of Right of Way) component (PPNO CP035), under Resolution TIRCP-2021-10. In June 2021, the Commission approved an allocation amendment to revise the component name to Trackwork and Stations: Lodi, City College, Midtown, Natomas Station and Layover Facility and UPRR Track Work, under Resolution TIRCP 2021-31. In August 2022, an allocation amendment was approved to officially separate the component into five separate components in which the Old North Sacramento Station component (PPNO CP035O) received \$692,000, under Resolution TIRCP-2223-14.

In August 2021, the Commission approved \$14,460,000 for the PS&E phase of the 2018:19 Valley Rail (Trackwork and Stations: Lodi, Midtown, Natomas Station and Layover facility and UPRR TrackWork) component (PPNO CP035Y), under Resolution TIRCP-2122-01. In August 2022, the Commission approved an allocation amendment to officially separate the component into 11 separate components in which the Old North Sacramento Station component (PPNO CP035O), received \$381,000, under Resolution TIRCP-2223-26.

The RW and PS&E allocations for this component were requested earlier than anticipated due to the Project Approval and Environmental Document phase not being completed at the time this component was separated. This amendment will rescind a combined total of \$1,073,000 from the RW and PS&E phases, which will be reprogrammed to other components within the (2018:19) Valley Rail project.

The proposed changes are reflected in strikethrough and bold in the attached revised vote boxes.

## **FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Be it Resolved, that the TIRCP (2018:19) Valley Rail (Old North Sacramento Station) component (PPNO CP035O), is hereby amended to rescind a combined total of \$1,073,000 from the RW and PS&E phases, in accordance with the attached revised vote boxes.
