Subject: Local Partnership Formulaic Program Amendment, Resolution LPP-P-2425-02, Amending Resolution LPP-P-2324-12

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an amendment to the Local Partnership Formulaic Program with the following actions:

- Add the Bellam Boulevard Off-Ramp Improvement Project in Marin County and program \$1,204,000 to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25.
- Add the National Trails Highway Bridge Replacements (3 Bridges) Project in San Bernardino County and program \$263,000 to the Project Approval & Environmental Document phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25 and \$263,000 to the Plans, Specifications, & Estimates phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25.
- Add the National Trails Highway Bridge Replacements (30 Bridges) Project in San Bernardino County and program \$2,625,000 to the Project Approval & Environmental Document phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25 and \$2,625,000 to the Plans, Specifications, & Estimates phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26.
- Add the Downtown Pavement Resurfacing Project in Contra Costa County and program \$400,000 to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25.

<u>lssue:</u>

Commission staff recommend the addition of four new projects, as summarized below:

 The Transportation Authority of Marin requests to add the Bellam Boulevard Off-Ramp Improvement project in Marin County and program \$1,204,000 to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25. This project will widen the off-ramp from Northbound US 101 to two lanes to separate the traffic turning left at Bellam Boulevard from the traffic turning onto Eastbound I-580 and will improve the crosswalk across Bellam Boulevard. The anticipated benefits include reconnecting a historically disadvantaged community to the City of San Rafael, reducing congestion during peak travel hours, and increasing off-ramp vehicle storage.

- The San Bernardino County Transportation Authority requests to add the National Trails Highway Bridge Replacements Project in San Bernardino County. This project will be split into two components. The first component will replace three bridges along the National Trails Highway. The second component will replace thirty bridges along the National Trails Highway. The anticipated benefits of this project will be the restoration of accessibility for all roadway users, improved safety, increased intermodal and multimodal freight mobility and reduced air pollution and greenhouse gas emissions. The project components will be programmed as follows:
 - \$263,000 in the Project Approval & Environmental Document phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25 and \$263,000 in the Plans, Specifications, & Estimates phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25 will be programmed for the National Trails Highway Bridge Replacements (3 Bridges) Project.
 - \$2,625,000 in the Project Approval & Environmental Document phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25 and \$2,625,000 in the Plans, Specifications, & Estimates phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26 will be programmed for the National Trails Highway Bridge Replacements (30 Bridges) Project.
- The City of Martinez requests to add the Downtown Pavement Resurfacing Project in Contra Costa County and program \$400,000 to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25. This project will include approximately 3.9 miles of road rehabilitation, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) curb ramp improvements, and striping restoration. The anticipated benefits include the rehabilitation of weathered and damaged road segments, an improvement to the pavement condition index with a fifteen- to twentyyear design life, and a reduced future need for repairs.

Background:

Senate Bill (SB) 1 (Beall, Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) created the Local Partnership Program. Assembly Bill 115 (Committee on Budget, Chapter 20, Statutes of 2017) clarified SB 1 language regarding local and regional transportation agency eligibility and expanded the types of projects eligible for the program. SB 1 authorizes \$200 million annually to fund the Local Partnership Program.

The Local Partnership Formulaic Program provides funding to counties, cities, districts, and regional transportation agencies in which voters have approved fees, taxes, or tolls dedicated solely to transportation improvements. Only agencies included in the Commission-adopted Local Partnership Formulaic Program Funding Distribution are eligible to request funding for projects in the Local Partnership Formulaic Program.

Resolution LPP-P-2324-12:

Be it Resolved that the Commission does hereby amend the Local Partnership Formulaic Program to:

- 1. Add the Bellam Boulevard Off-Ramp Improvement Project in Marin County and program \$1,204,000 to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25.
- 2. Add the National Trails Highway Bridge Replacements (3 Bridges) Project in San Bernardino County and program \$263,000 to the Project Approval & Environmental Document phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25 and \$263,000 to the Plans, Specifications, & Estimates phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25.
- 3. Add the National Trails Highway Bridge Replacements (30 Bridges) Project in San Bernardino County and program \$2,625,000 to the Project Approval & Environmental Document phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25 and \$2,625,000 to the Plans, Specifications, & Estimates phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26.
- 4. Add the Downtown Pavement Resurfacing Project in Contra Costa County and program \$400,000 to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2024-25.
