ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$7,100,000 for the locally-administered multi-funded State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)/Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) Trade Corridor Enhancement Program (TCEP) Centennial Corridor SB99 to WB58 Connector project (PPNO 8030), on the State Highway System, in Kern County, programmed in Fiscal Year 2025-26?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$7,100,000 for the locally-administered multi-funded STIP/SB 1 TCEP Centennial Corridor SB99 to WB58 Connector project (PPNO 8030), on the State Highway System, in Kern County, programmed in 2025-26.

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes the locally-administered multi-funded STIP/SB 1 TCEP project totaling \$7,100,000. The local agency is ready to proceed with this project, and is requesting an allocation at this time.
