## **RE:** Commission Agenda Tab #59: Support for Staff Recommendation

Dear Chair Guardino:

On behalf of Monterey-Salinas Transit, we support California Transportation Commission staff's recommendation for approval of tab #59 on your Commission's agenda for December 5 & 6. The item is to approve a credit for Monterey Branch Line property purchased with Proposition 116 funds.

You may recall from your California Transportation Commission visit to Monterey in June during your transportation tour, the SURF! Busway and Bus Rapid Transit Project supports statewide goals to support climate action, reduce GHG emissions, serve disadvantaged communities, and better serve ALL residents. The SURF! Project is on CalSTA's Cycle 5 Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program award list for \$25M.

MST supports this Commission action because it aligns with years of planning and local support for the SURF! Project. The Project is a 6-mile bus rapid transit project which will bring frequent and reliable bus service to residents of Monterey County including those in disadvantaged communities as well as Salinas, Marina, Sand City, Seaside, and Monterey. Transit connections to other lines will serve the entire Monterey County service area.

After years of careful planning, the California Coastal Commission approved a Coastal Development Permit for the SURF! Project which requires the busway alignment to be located atop the railroad tracks. Although the railroad tracks will be removed, the alignment change still allows for and supports a future rail project. There remains adequate space along the 100' wide corridor for rail service when it becomes viable whether it be commuter, intercity, or light rail.

Additionally, MST is working together with the Federal Transit Administration to secure a Capital Investment Grant for over \$22.17M for the SURF! Project by January 14<sup>th</sup>. The California Transportation Commission's action today is an approval necessary to secure this federal funding for the SURF! Project.

Finally, MST has received numerous letters of support for the SURF! Project including from the California Air Resources Board, California Department of Transportation, Monterey Bay Aquarium, Monterey Bay Air Resources Board, Monterey County Board of Supervisors, Monterey County Mayors' Association, and many more. Again, we support your approval of tab #59 and look forward to inviting the California Transportation Commission to groundbreaking in spring 2025.
