



G-12 Progress Report through December 2024

- G-12's represent delegated authority to make adjustments (increases or decreases) to project funding
- Through December 2024, Caltrans has processed the following changes:
 - SHOPP: Approximately \$49 million in increases from 56 projects, and \$141 million in savings from 86 projects
 - STIP: \$297,000 in increases from one project and \$909,600 in savings from five projects






2024-25 Allocations Through December Commission Meeting (Percent Allocated of Total Annual Capacity)
