ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$32,100,000 for the State-Administered Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) Trade Corridor Enhancement Program (TCEP) Castroville Boulevard Interchange project (PPNO 0057D), on the State Highway System, in Monterey County?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$32,100,000 for the State-Administered SB 1 TCEP Castroville Boulevard Interchange project (PPNO 0057D), on the State Highway System, in Monterey County.

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes the State-Administered SB 1 TCEP project totaling \$32,100,000. The Department is ready to proceed with this project, and is requesting an allocation at this time.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved, that \$32,100,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2023, Budget Act Item 2660-301-3291 for the State-Administered SB 1 TCEP project described on the attached vote list.
