**Subject:** Local Partnership Formulaic Program Amendment, Resolution LPP-P-2526-04  
Amending Resolution LPP-P-2526-01

## **Recommendation:**

Staff recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an amendment to the Local Partnership Formulaic Program with the following actions, which are individually noted in Attachment A:

- Program \$168,000 in Supplemental Funds to the Santa Barbara US 101 Multimodal Corridor Project - Segment 4E North-Cabrillo Interchange in Santa Barbara County.
- Add nine projects in Contra Costa, San Francisco, Marin, Sonoma, and Sacramento Counties and program \$17,543,000.

## **Issue:**

Commission staff reviewed each request to amend the Local Partnership Formulaic Program, and each request is summarized below:

- Santa Barbara County Association of Governments requests to amend the U.S. 101 Multimodal Corridor Project - Segment 4E North-Cabrillo Interchange in Santa Barbara County and program an additional \$168,000 in supplemental funds from its remaining 2024 Formulaic Program funding to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26. This action adds \$168,000 in 2024 Formulaic Program funds to the already programmed \$2,511,000, resulting in a total of \$2,679,000 in 2024 Formulaic Program funds in Fiscal Year 2025-26 on the Construction phase. The supplemental funds will reduce a portion of local funds that are committed to the project, which is allowable in the program. The project will construct High Occupancy Vehicle lanes to help reduce congestion and delays, improve goods movement, and provide a more efficient alternative route for north-south connectivity.

- City of Martinez requests to add the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Pavement Maintenance and Rehabilitation Project in Contra Costa County and program \$400,000 of its 2024 Formulaic Program funding to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26. The project will enhance the overall condition of the City's streets, improve ADA curb ramps, and restore street striping.
- Bay Area Toll Authority (BATA) requests to add the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge West Span Superstructure Paint Project in San Francisco County. As part of this request, San Francisco County Transportation Authority is also transferring \$4,500,000 of its 2022 Formulaic funding to BATA for use on this project. Formulaic funding will be programmed on the project as follows:
  - \$7,389,000 of BATA's 2022 Formulaic Program funding to the Construction Support phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26
  - \$4,500,000 of San Francisco County Transportation Authority's 2022 Formulaic Program funding to the Construction Support phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26

This results in a total of \$11,889,000 of 2022 Formulaic funding being programmed to the Construction Support phase of this project in Fiscal Year 2025-26. The project will protect the bridge against the harsh marine environment by preserving the structural integrity and extending its useful service-life.

- Sonoma Marin Area Rail Transit (SMART) requests to add two projects in Marin and Sonoma Counties.
  - Hi-Rail Boom-Bucket Truck Acquisition Project - Program \$200,000 of its 2020 Formulaic Program funding (resulting from recent project cost savings) to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26. Acquisition of the truck will allow for timely safety improvements, inspections, and maintenance of SMART's right-of-way.
  - Battery-Powered Railcar Mover Acquisition Project - Program \$16,000 of its 2020 Formulaic Program funding (resulting from recent project cost savings) and \$84,000 of its 2022 Formulaic Program funding, for a total of \$100,000, to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26. Acquisition of the railcar will prevent service disruptions, help ensure safety standards are maintained and allow for immediate maintenance needs to be addressed.
- Sacramento Transportation Authority requests to add five projects in Sacramento County:
  - Marysville Boulevard Vision Zero Project - Program \$518,000 of its 2022 Formulaic funding to the Plans, Specifications, and Estimates phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26. The project will enhance safety for all users with traffic calming improvements, pedestrian crossing improvements, separated bikeways, and pavement repair in the City of Sacramento.

- 2026 Pavement Maintenance Project Treatments (LPP Streets) - Program \$581,000 of its 2024 Formulaic Program funding to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2026-27. The project will help ensure that the pavement condition index of over 40 street locations in the City of Elk Grove stays at a level that will extend the lifespan of the road by performing surface treatments and adding new traffic striping.
- Folsom Boulevard Pavement Resurfacing Project - Program \$572,000 of its 2024 Formulaic Program funding to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2026-27. The project will extend and preserve the lifespan of Folsom Boulevard in the City of Folsom and mitigate current safety risks from aging pavement.
- Broadway Vision Zero Project - Program \$1,168,000 of its 2024 Formulaic funding to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2026-27. The project will install buffered Class II bike lanes, reduce travel lanes, improve pedestrian crossings and traffic signals, and resurface pavement to improve safety for all users of the Broadway corridor in the City of Sacramento.
- AC Overlay Project 2026 Phase C - Program \$2,115,000 of its 2024 Formulaic funding to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2026-27. The project will rehabilitate 9 lane-miles of local road and make ADA improvements to increase the pavement conditions in the Foothill Farms, Fair Oaks, and Arden-Arcade Communities in Sacramento County.

These actions leave \$28,483,000 of the 2022 Local Partnership Formulaic Program funding available for programming through June 30, 2026, and \$89,172,000 of the 2024 Local Partnership Formulaic Program funding available for programming through June 30, 2028.

**Background:**

Senate Bill (SB) 1 (Beall, Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) created the Local Partnership Program. Assembly Bill 115 (Committee on Budget, Chapter 20, Statutes of 2017) clarified SB 1 language regarding local and regional transportation agency eligibility and expanded the types of projects eligible for the program. SB 1 authorizes \$200 million annually to fund the Local Partnership Program.

The Local Partnership Formulaic Program provides funding to counties, cities, districts, and regional transportation agencies in which voters have approved fees, taxes, or tolls dedicated solely to transportation improvements. Only agencies included in the Commission-adopted Local Partnership Formulaic Program Funding Distribution are eligible to request funding for projects in the Local Partnership Formulaic Program.

**Resolution LPP-P-2526-04:**

Be it Resolved that the Commission does hereby amend the Local Partnership Formulaic Program to:

1. Program \$168,000 in Supplemental Funds to the Santa Barbara US 101 Multimodal Corridor Project- Segment 4E North-Cabrillo Interchange in Santa Barbara County.
2. Add nine projects in Contra Costa, San Francisco, Marin, Sonoma, and Sacramento Counties and program \$17,543,000.
