ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$10,000,000 for the locally-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) I-280/Wolfe Road Interchange Improvement project (PPNO 2091M), on the State Highway System, in Santa Clara County?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$10,000,000 for the locally-administered STIP I-280/Wolfe Road Interchange Improvement project (PPNO 2091M), on the State Highway System, in Santa Clara County.

BACKGROUND:
