RESOLUTION FP-25-54**

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$461,000 for four locally-administered Local Alternative Transportation Improvement Program (LATIP) projects, off the State Highway System?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$461,000 for four locally-administered LATIP projects, off the State Highway System.

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes four locally-administered LATIP projects totaling \$461,000. The local agencies are ready to proceed with these projects, and are requesting an allocation at this time.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved, that \$461,000 be allocated from Budget Act 2025, Budget Act Item 2660-102-0042 for four locally-administered LATIP projects described on the attached vote list.
