Subject: **ALLOCATION FOR A LOCALLY-ADMINISTERED SENATE BILL 1 LOCAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (FORMULAIC) PROJECT, OFF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM RESOLUTION LPP-A-2526-07**

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$2,500,000 for the locally-administered Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) Local Partnership Program (LPP) (Formulaic) Bascom Complete Streets (I-880 to Hamilton Ave) project (PPNO 2364R), off the State Highway System, in Santa Clara County?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$2,500,000 for the locally-administered SB 1 LPP (Formulaic) Bascom Complete Streets (I-880 to Hamilton Ave) project (PPNO 2364R), off the State Highway System, in Santa Clara County.

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes the locally-administered SB 1 LPP (Formulaic) project totaling \$2,500,000. The local agency is ready to proceed with this project, and is requesting an allocation at this time.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:
