ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$450,000 for the locally-administered Local Transportation Climate Adaptation Program (LTCAP) 14th Street Underpass Stormwater Pump Station Planning project (PPNO 1345), off the State Highway System, in Riverside County, programmed in Fiscal Year 2026-27?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$450,000 for the locally-administered LTCAP 14th Street Underpass Stormwater Pump Station Planning project (PPNO 1345), off the State Highway System, in Riverside County, programmed in 2026-27.

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes the locally-administered LTCAP project totaling \$450,000. The local agency is ready to proceed with this project, and is requesting an allocation at this time.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:
