Subject: **ALLOCATION AMENDMENT FOR A TRANSIT AND INTERCITY RAIL CAPITAL PROGRAM COMPONENT**
RESOLUTION TIRCP-2526-16, AMENDING RESOLUTION TIRCP-2425-14

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation amendment for the Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program (TIRCP) (2022:04) Sacramento Valley Station (SVS) Transit Center: Priority Projects (Contactless EMV Readers Placer County Transit) component (PPNO CP094Q), in Placer County, to rescind the full amount of \$92,000 from the Construction (CON) phase due to local funds covering the costs?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the Commission approve an allocation amendment for the TIRCP (2022:04) Sacramento Valley Station (SVS) Transit Center: Priority Projects (Contactless EMV Readers Placer County Transit) component (PPNO CP094Q), in Placer County, to rescind the full amount of \$92,000 from the CON phase due to local funds covering the costs.

BACKGROUND:

In August 2024, the Commission approved \$92,000 for the CON phase of the TIRCP (2022:04) Sacramento Valley Station (SVS) Transit Center: Priority Projects (Contactless EMV Readers Placer County Transit) component (PPNO CP094Q), under Resolution TIRCP-2425-14. In fall of 2024, Placer County Transit (PCT) determined their outdated fare collection equipment necessitated a full system upgrade. The agency delivered the purchase and installation of their selected farebox equipment, which integrates both cash and contactless payment functions, using locally allocated Transportation Development Act

funds. PCT's locally-funded full system upgrade renders the \$92,000 of TIRCP funds redundant.

Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) has determined that a partner transit operator, South County Transit (SCTLink), has the need for new contactless Europay, Mastercard and Visa (EMV) readers on all its vehicles, and requests the \$92,000 be reallocated for use to purchase and install the EMV readers through a Master Service Agreement between Sacramento Regional Transit and California Integrated Travel Project. The implementation of SCTLink's contactless EMV readers will be completed within the project's existing timeline. In August 2025, the California State Transportation Agency approved the expansion of the project scope to include the South County Transit Contactless EMV Readers component.

The \$92,000 that is being rescinded will be reprogrammed to the Contactless EMV Readers South County Transit component (PPNO CP094V). Therefore, the Department is requesting this allocation amendment to rescind the full amount of \$92,000 from the CON phase of the Contactless EMV Readers Placer County Transit Component (PPNO CP094Q). There is a concurrent allocation on this month's Commission agenda.

The proposed changes are reflected in strikethrough and bold in the attached revised vote box.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved, that the TIRCP (2022:04) Sacramento Valley Station (SVS) Transit Center: Priority Projects (Contactless EMV Readers Placer County Transit) component (PPNO CP094Q), is hereby amended to rescind the full amount of \$92,000 from the CON phase, in accordance with the attached revised vote box.
