ASSISTANCE ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM PROJECTS, PER ATP

GUIDELINES

ACTION UPDATE: Update to the Summary, Background and status tables.

SUMMARY:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) is presenting this item for information purposes only. The item provides the status of locally-administered Active Transportation Program (ATP) projects that received a construction allocation in Fiscal Year 2023-24 through 2025-26.

In 2023-24, the California Transportation Commission (Commission) allocated \$197,991,000 to construct 87 ATP projects. As of September 11, 2025, 78 projects totaling \$118,061,000 have been awarded. One project has lapsed and two projects have concurrent time extension amendment requests on this month's agenda. Six projects have time extensions that are scheduled to award by the extended deadline.

In 2024-25, the Commission allocated \$238,666,000 to construct 64 locally-administered ATP projects. As of September 11, 2025, 20 projects totaling \$40,095,000 have been awarded and four projects have a concurrent time extension request on this month's agenda. Eleven projects have approved time extensions,13 are scheduled to award by the deadline and 16 are scheduled to award by the Interim Timely Use of Funds (ITUF) deadline.

In 2025-26, the Commission allocated \$17,395,000 to construct four locally-administered ATP projects. As of September 11, 2025, all four projects are scheduled to award by the deadline.

BACKGROUND:

Current ATP Guidelines require projects to be ready to proceed to construction within six months of allocation. On June 26, 2025, the Commission adopted the 2025 ITUF Policy, Southern California Fires, for affected counties, under Resolution G-25-51, which extends the period of construction contract award from six months to 12 months, applicable through the duration of the ITUF Policy. This extension is retroactive and includes allocations approved at the January, March, May, and June 2025 Commission meetings. The policy also requires the Department to report to the Commission those projects that have not been awarded within four months of allocation.
