ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$5,000,000 for the locally-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Folsom Light Rail Station Conversion transit project, (PPNO 6501), in Sacramento County?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$5,000,000 for the locally-administered STIP Folsom Light Rail Station Conversion transit project, (PPNO 6501), in Sacramento County.

BACKGROUND:
