Subject: Local Partnership Formulaic Program Amendment, Resolution LPP-P-2526-10,
Amending Resolution LPP-P-2526-08

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an amendment to the Local Partnership Formulaic Program with the following actions, which are individually noted in Attachment A:

- Program \$41,000 in Supplemental Funds to five projects in Imperial County.
- Add three projects in Napa, San Mateo, Santa Clara, and Amador Counties and program \$4,580,000.

Issue:

Commission staff reviewed each request to amend the Local Partnership Formulaic Program, and each request is summarized below:

- Imperial County Local Transportation Authority requests to amend five projects in Imperial County and program a total of \$41,000 in supplemental funds from its 2022 Formulaic Program funding:
 - Gillett Road Rehabilitation Project from Evan Hewes Highway to Cooley Road - Program an additional \$15,000 in supplemental funds from its remaining 2022 Formulaic Program funding to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26. This action adds \$15,000 in 2022 Formulaic Program funds to the already programmed \$216,000, resulting in a total of \$231,000 in 2022 and 2024 Formulaic Program funds in Fiscal Year 2025-26 on the Construction phase. The supplemental funds will be used to make additional curb and gutter improvements. The project will rehabilitate one-half mile of deteriorating existing roadway in the City of El Centro.

- Pine Avenue Revitalization and Pedestrian Improvement Project - Program an additional \$2,000 in supplemental funds from its remaining 2022 Formulaic Program funding to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26. This action adds \$2,000 in 2022 Formulaic Program funds to the already programmed \$38,000, resulting in a total of \$40,000 in 2022 and 2024 Formulaic Program funds in Fiscal Year 2025-26 on the Construction phase. The supplemental funds will be used to cover additional construction costs. The project will construct new sidewalk, curb, and gutter on both sides of Pine Avenue in the City of Holtville.
- Cole Boulevard between Scaroni Road and Railroad Crossing Rehabilitation Project - Program an additional \$13,000 in supplemental funds from its remaining 2022 Formulaic Program funding to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26. This action adds \$13,000 in 2022 Formulaic Program funds to the already programmed \$191,000, resulting in a total of \$204,000 in 2022 and 2024 Formulaic Program funds in Fiscal Year 2025-26 on the Construction phase. The supplemental funds will be used to cover additional material costs. The project will complete an extensive overlay of an existing roadway, which serves as a link to the East Port-of-Entry in the City of Calexico.
- Mainstreet Roadway Improvements Project - Program an additional \$1,000 in supplemental funds from its remaining 2022 Formulaic Program funding to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26. This action adds \$1,000 in 2022 Formulaic Program funds to the already programmed \$29,000, resulting in a total of \$30,000 in 2022 and 2024 Formulaic Program funds in Fiscal Year 2025-26 on the Construction phase. The supplemental funds will be used to cover additional construction costs. The project will rehabilitate a section of roadway that serves as a major conduit for commercial, agricultural, and industrial traffic, which will improve safety for all users in the City of Calipatria.
- Western Avenue Pedestrian Improvements Project - Program an additional \$10,000 in supplemental funds from its remaining 2022 Formulaic Program funding to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26. This action adds \$10,000 in 2022 Formulaic Program funds to the already programmed \$142,000, resulting in a total of \$152,000 in 2022 and 2024 Formulaic Program funds in Fiscal Year 2025-26 on the Construction phase. The supplemental funds will be used to make additional pedestrian improvements. The project will install ADA ramps and new sidewalks to improve safety for all users in the City of Brawley.
- Napa Valley Transportation Authority requests to add the Redwood Park and Ride Capital Improvement Project in Napa County and program \$538,000 of its 2022 Formulaic Program funds to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26. The project will improve a key transit hub in the City of Napa by installing a new restroom facility and upgrading wayfinding signage, striping, and pavement.
- Caltrain requests to add the San Francisquito Creek Bridge Bank Stabilization Project in San Mateo and Santa Clara Counties and program \$1,912,000 of its 2022 Formulaic Program funds and \$1,930,000 of its 2024 Formulaic Program funds to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26, for a total of \$3,842,000 in Formulaic Program funds. The project will protect the Caltrain railroad bridge and Palo Alto's bicycle-pedestrian bridge

by stabilizing eroded creek banks and replacing aging storm drain outfall with modern and more resilient features.

- City of Amador requests to add the Amador City-Old Highway 49 Resurfacing, Ped/Bike Crossings and Sidewalk Improvement Project in Amador County and program \$200,000 of its 2022 Formulaic Program funds to the Project Approval and Environmental Document phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26. The project will rehabilitate over one-half mile of Old Highway 49, which runs across the City and will enhance pedestrian safety and encourage non-motorized travel.

These actions leave \$18,301,000 of the 2022 Local Partnership Formulaic Program funding available for programming through June 30, 2026, and \$87,242,000 of the 2024 Local Partnership Formulaic Program funding available for programming through June 30, 2028.

Background:

Senate Bill (SB) 1 (Beall, Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) created the Local Partnership Program. Assembly Bill 115 (Committee on Budget, Chapter 20, Statutes of 2017) clarified SB 1 language regarding local and regional transportation agency eligibility and expanded the types of projects eligible for the program. SB 1 authorizes \$200 million annually to fund the Local Partnership Program.

The Local Partnership Formulaic Program provides funding to counties, cities, districts, and regional transportation agencies in which voters have approved fees, taxes, or tolls dedicated solely to transportation improvements. Only agencies included in the Commission-adopted Local Partnership Formulaic Program Funding Distribution are eligible to request funding for projects in the Local Partnership Formulaic Program.

Resolution LPP-P-2526-10:

Be it Resolved that the Commission does hereby amend the Local Partnership Formulaic Program to:

1. Amend five projects in Imperial County and program \$41,000 in supplemental Local Partnership Formulaic Program funds to each project's Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26.
2. Add one project in Napa County and program \$538,000 in Local Partnership Formulaic Program funds to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26.
3. Add one project in San Mateo and Santa Clara Counties and program \$3,842,000 in Local Partnership Formulaic Program funds to the Construction phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26.
4. Add one project in Amador County and program \$200,000 in Local Partnership Formulaic Program funds to the Project Approval and Environmental Document phase in Fiscal Year 2025-26.
