ON THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM  
RESOLUTION FP-25-75**

### **ISSUE:**

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$72,889,000 for the locally-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Interstate 10 Corridor Freight and Managed Lane Project: Sierra Ave to Pepper Ave, Contract 2B (PPNO 1326), on the State Highway System, in San Bernardino County?

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$72,889,000 for the locally-administered STIP Interstate 10 Corridor Freight and Managed Lane Project: Sierra Ave to Pepper Ave, Contract 2B (PPNO 1326), on the State Highway System, in San Bernardino County.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The attached vote list describes the locally-administered STIP project totaling \$72,889,000. The local agency is ready to proceed with this project, and is requesting an allocation at this time.

**FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved, that \$72,889,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2025, Budget Act Items 2660-301-0042 and 2660-301-0890 for the locally-administered STIP project described on the attached vote list.
