Statistics

Current Uses (highlights):

- 180 Telecommunication
- 179 Parking
- 14 Open Storage
- 12 Mini-Storage

Inspections: 153 out of 155 inspections passed.

State Fire Marshal Inspections: 38 sites have outstanding failed SFM Inspections

- 21 are in the process of correcting
- 14 are not correctable due to existing structures
- 3 sites are mini-storage facilities that require follow-up inspections
- 19 new failures

Holdovers: 133 Leases are on hold over (Addressed in an upcoming slide)

Open Storage

- D4: 6
 - D7: 7
 - D11: 1
- ▶ Prior to October 2025, districts were instructed to issue termination notices.
 - ▶ 10 sites
 - ▶ Remaining sites will be re-evaluated for exceptions or possible change in use





Holdovers

- NR: 7
 - D4: 70
 - D7: 40
 - D8: 2
 - D10: 1
 - D11: 11
 - D12: 2
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- ▶ 133 Holdovers are under evaluation
 - ▶ Some may be terminated
 - ▶ Some are on hold until properties can be auctioned

State Fire Marshal(SFM) Reports

SFM Violation Corrections

- Monitored by District Staff
- Require reinspection
- Unresolvable violations (demolition)
 - Structure is ceiling of the building
 - Lighting and sprinkler systems

Collaboration HQ & District

- Identify violations
- Demolition costs
- Legal review
