Subject: **STATUS OF ALLOCATION FOR SHOPP PROJECTS**

SUMMARY:

The California Department of Transportation is presenting this information item to provide the status of construction contract allocation for projects on the State Highway System planned for allocation in Fiscal Year 2025-26.

According to State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) Guidelines adopted by the California Transportation Commission (Commission) in December 2024, whenever programmed funds are not allocated by the end of the programmed fiscal year or by the date of a Commission approved extension, the project will be considered lapsed and will be deprogrammed from the SHOPP.

This report lists projects that did not allocate by the January 2026 Commission meeting and will lapse.
