Subject: **ALLOCATION AMENDMENT FOR A LOCALLY-ADMINISTERED SENATE BILL 1 SOLUTIONS FOR CONGESTED CORRIDORS PROGRAM PROJECT, OFF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM RESOLUTION SCCP-A-2526-07, AMENDING RESOLUTION SCCP-A-2425-04**

### **ISSUE:**

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation amendment for the locally-administered Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) Solutions for Congested Corridors Program (SCCP) Zero Emission Vehicle Infrastructure project (PPNO 3203), off the State Highway System, in Santa Barbara County, to deallocate \$168,000 from the Construction (CON) phase to reflect project savings and to revise the project description and outcome/outputs?

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation amendment for the locally-administered SB 1 SCCP Zero Emission Vehicle Infrastructure project (PPNO 3203), off the State Highway System, in Santa Barbara County, to deallocate \$168,000 from the CON phase to reflect project savings and to revise the project description and outcome/outputs.

### **BACKGROUND:**

In June 2025, the Commission allocated \$575,000 for the CON phase of the locally-administered, SB 1 SCCP Zero Emission Vehicle Infrastructure project (PPNO 3203), under Resolution SCCP-A-2425-04. This project was programmed to install a direct current (DC) Fast Charger in Summerland at Wallace Avenue. That location was determined infeasible after Southern California Edison's Rule 29 evaluation found the site could not be served. Santa Barbara County (County) subsequently evaluated two additional locations in Summerland, but neither proved feasible due to site constraints and project delivery timelines. Because no

viable location was identified in Summerland, the County is requesting to deallocate \$168,000 associated with the programmed Wallace Avenue site from the overall project.

The proposed changes are reflected in strikethrough and bold in the attached revised vote box. There is a concurrent contract award post-fact time extension request for the CON phase on this month's Commission agenda.

**FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved, that the locally-administered SB 1 SCCP Zero Emission Vehicle Infrastructure project (PPNO 3203), is hereby amended to deallocate \$168,000 from the CON phase to reflect project savings and to revise the project description and outcome/outputs, in accordance with the attached revised vote box.
