Subject: **ALLOCATION AMENDMENT FOR A LOCALLY-ADMINISTERED LOCAL TRANSPORTATION CLIMATE ADAPTATION PROGRAM PROJECT, OFF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM**
RESOLUTION LTCAP-A-2526-06, AMENDING RESOLUTION LTCAP-A-2324-05

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation amendment for the locally-administered Local Transportation Climate Adaptation Program (LTCAP) Roe Road Phase 2 project (PPNO 3890), off the State Highway System, in Butte County, to add the minor scope change note and revise the description and outcome/outputs?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation amendment for the locally-administered LTCAP Roe Road Phase 2 project (PPNO 3890), off the State Highway System, in Butte County, to add the minor scope change note and revise the description and outcome/outputs.

BACKGROUND:

In June 2024, the Commission approved \$1,770,000 for the Project Approval and Environmental Document phase of the locally-administered LTCAP Roe Road Phase 2 project (PPNO 3890), under Resolution LTCAP-A-2324-05. Since the time of allocation, the Town of Paradise (Town) has received numerous comments from the local community and property owners, particularly those along the alignment of the project, opposing the proposed changes to the land and roadway. The part of town where these changes would be made is rural, and the property owners expressed that making such extensive changes would negatively impact this part of town.

The approved minor scope change is replacing the Class I multi-use path with Class II bike lanes on each side of the new two-lane roadway that can be used as emergency response and evacuation lanes when needed but would be Class II bike lanes for day-to-day operations. This scope change addresses the concerns of the community while still meeting the original intent of having extra access during emergency situations.

The approved changes are reflected in strikethrough and bold in the attached revised vote box. There is no change to the allocation amount.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved, that the locally-administered LTCAP Roe Road Phase 2 project (PPNO 3890), is hereby amended to add the minor scope change note and revise the description and outcome/outputs, in accordance with the attached revised vote box.
