Development of the 2027 ATP Fund Estimate

- Resources
 - Assumes consistent state funding levels
 - Federal funding include estimates from the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) level and escalated at 1.8 percent
 - Includes redistribution of unused federal Transportation Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act (TIFIA) funding
- Adjustments
 - Excludes previously programmed revenues and resources for the 2029 ATP Fund Estimate
- No changes from the Draft Fund Estimate
