## **Recommendation:**

Staff recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an amendment to the 2022 Solutions for Congested Corridors Program and 2023 Active Transportation Program multi-funded Baseline Agreement submitted in accordance with the Commission's Senate Bill (SB) 1 Accountability and Transparency Guidelines and establish the agreement as the basis for project delivery and monitoring.

The Ventura County Transportation Commission's U.S. 101 Connected Communities Corridor Rail and Active Transportation Improvements Baseline Agreement amendment reflects the program amendments recommended for Commission approval at this meeting under Reference items 4.19 and 4.26.

## **Issue:**

The implementing agency requests Commission approval of an amendment to the U.S. 101 Connected Communities Corridor Rail and Active Transportation Improvements Baseline Agreement. This project was programmed in the 2022 Solutions for Congested Corridors Program and the 2023 Active Transportation Program Metropolitan Planning Organization Component.

Reference items 4.19 and 4.26 on this agenda request Commission approval of program amendments to the 2023 Active Transportation Program and 2022 Solutions for Congested Corridors Program, respectively. Approval of those amendments requires a corresponding update to the Baseline Agreement originally approved in May 2024.

Commission staff has reviewed the amended Baseline Agreement and determined that the project's benefits, schedule, costs, and funding plan remain consistent with the Commission-approved amendments and program commitments. Approval of this amendment will establish the updated basis for project delivery and monitoring.

**Background:**

The Commission adopted the revised SB 1 Accountability and Transparency Guidelines at its May 15, 2025, meeting. The Guidelines direct agencies to provide executed Baseline Agreements that set forth the agreed-upon expected benefits, delivery schedule, project cost, and funding plan. The Baseline Agreement provides a benchmark for comparison to the current status of a project for subsequent reporting purposes. The Baseline Agreement must be signed by the California Department of Transportation Director and District Director, the Commission's Executive Director, the project applicant, and the implementing agency.

During the May 2024 Commission meeting, the Commission approved the original Baseline Agreement for the U.S. 101 Connected Communities Corridor Rail and Active Transportation Improvements project.

**Resolution SCCP-P-2526-09BA and Resolution ATP-P-2526-16B**

Be It Resolved, that the Commission hereby amends the multi-funded Solutions for Congested Corridors Program and Active Transportation Program Baseline Agreement for the U.S. 101 Connected Communities Corridor Rail and Active Transportation Improvements to reflect the program amendments under Reference items 4.19 and 4.26.
