Subject: **ALLOCATION FOR A STATE-ADMINISTERED MULTI-FUNDED SENATE BILL 1 LOCAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (FORMULAIC AND COMPETITIVE) AND SENATE BILL 1 TRADE CORRIDOR ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM PROJECT, ON THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM**

### **ISSUE:**

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$60,076,000 for the State-Administered multi-funded Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) Local Partnership Program (LPP) (Formulaic and Competitive) and SB 1 Trade Corridor Enhancement Program (TCEP) Castroville Boulevard Interchange project (PPNO 0057D), on the State Highway System, in Monterey County?

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$60,076,000 for the State-Administered multi-funded SB 1 LPP (Formulaic and Competitive) and SB 1 TCEP Castroville Boulevard Interchange project (PPNO 0057D), on the State Highway System, in Monterey County.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The attached vote list describes the State-Administered multi-funded SB 1 LPP (Formulaic and Competitive) and SB 1 TCEP project totaling \$60,076,000. The Department is ready to proceed with this project, and is requesting an allocation at this time.

**FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved, that \$50,976,000 be allocated from the Budget Acts of 2024 and 2025, Budget Act Items 2660-301-3291 and 2660-302-0890 and Non-Budget Act Item 2660-801-3290 for construction and \$9,100,000 for construction engineering for the State-Administered multi-funded SB 1 LPP (Formulaic and Competitive) and SB 1 TCEP project described on the attached vote list.

This allocation will split out and create two Child Projects- Landscape Planting and Biological Monitoring, under PPNO 0057Y and PPNO 0057X from this Parent project (PPNO 0057D) and fund it with \$5,678,000 in Local funds as follows: for PPNO 0057Y \$940,000 for PS&E in FY 26-27, \$30,000 for RW Sup in FY 26-27, \$1,050,000 for CON ENG and \$3,000,000 for CON phase in FY 28-29; and for PPNO 0057X \$8,000 for RW Sup in FY 27-28, and \$650,000 for CON ENG in FY 28-29.
