Subject: **ALLOCATION FOR A LOCALLY-ADMINISTERED SENATE BILL 1 SOLUTIONS FOR CONGESTED CORRIDORS PROGRAM TRANSIT PROJECT RESOLUTION SCCP-A-2526-10**

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve an allocation of \$1,173,000 for the locally-administered Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) Solutions for Congested Corridors Program (SCCP) Venice Blvd Bus Speed and Reliability – (Real-Time Passenger Info and Bus Shelters) Transit project (PPNO 6204), in Los Angeles County?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends that the Commission approve an allocation of \$1,173,000 for the locally-administered SB 1 SCCP Venice Blvd Bus Speed and Reliability – (Real-Time Passenger Info and Bus Shelters) Transit project (PPNO 6204), in Los Angeles County.

BACKGROUND:

The attached vote list describes the locally-administered SB 1 SCCP Transit project totaling \$1,173,000. The local agency is ready to proceed with this project, and is requesting an allocation at this time; however, the allocation is contingent upon the passage of the Budget Act of 2026.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved, that \$1,173,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2026, Budget Act Item 2660-109-0042 for the locally-administered SB 1 SCCP project described on the attached vote list.
