Subject: Innovations in Transportation: Advancing Accessible Autonomous Mobility

Summary:

Tim Haile, Executive Director of the Contra Costa Transportation Authority (CCTA), will share how CCTA's innovation work has evolved from testing autonomous mobility technologies in a controlled environment at GoMentum Station to deploying real-world pilots that improve accessible, first/last-mile connections to transit, medical care, jobs, community services, and daily needs for seniors and people with disabilities. The presentation will highlight CCTA's partnership-based approach to workforce development and operations as a model for how public agencies can help guide autonomous mobility.

Background:

CCTA has participated in early public agency efforts to test connected and autonomous vehicle technologies at [GoMentum Station](#), the nation's largest secure facility dedicated to evaluating emerging mobility technologies in a controlled environment. This work provides an opportunity for public agencies, private-sector partners, researchers, and technology developers to explore safety, operations, and potential applications before broader deployment.

CCTA's recent work has also included [pilot projects](#) focused on mobility options for communities with transportation access challenges. These pilots explore how autonomous and shared mobility technologies can support connections to transit and community needs and services.
