Subject: **VACATION RESOLUTION**

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the California Department of Transportation's (Department) request for a vacation resolution that will abandon the public's right to use as highway facilities?

RECOMMENDATION:

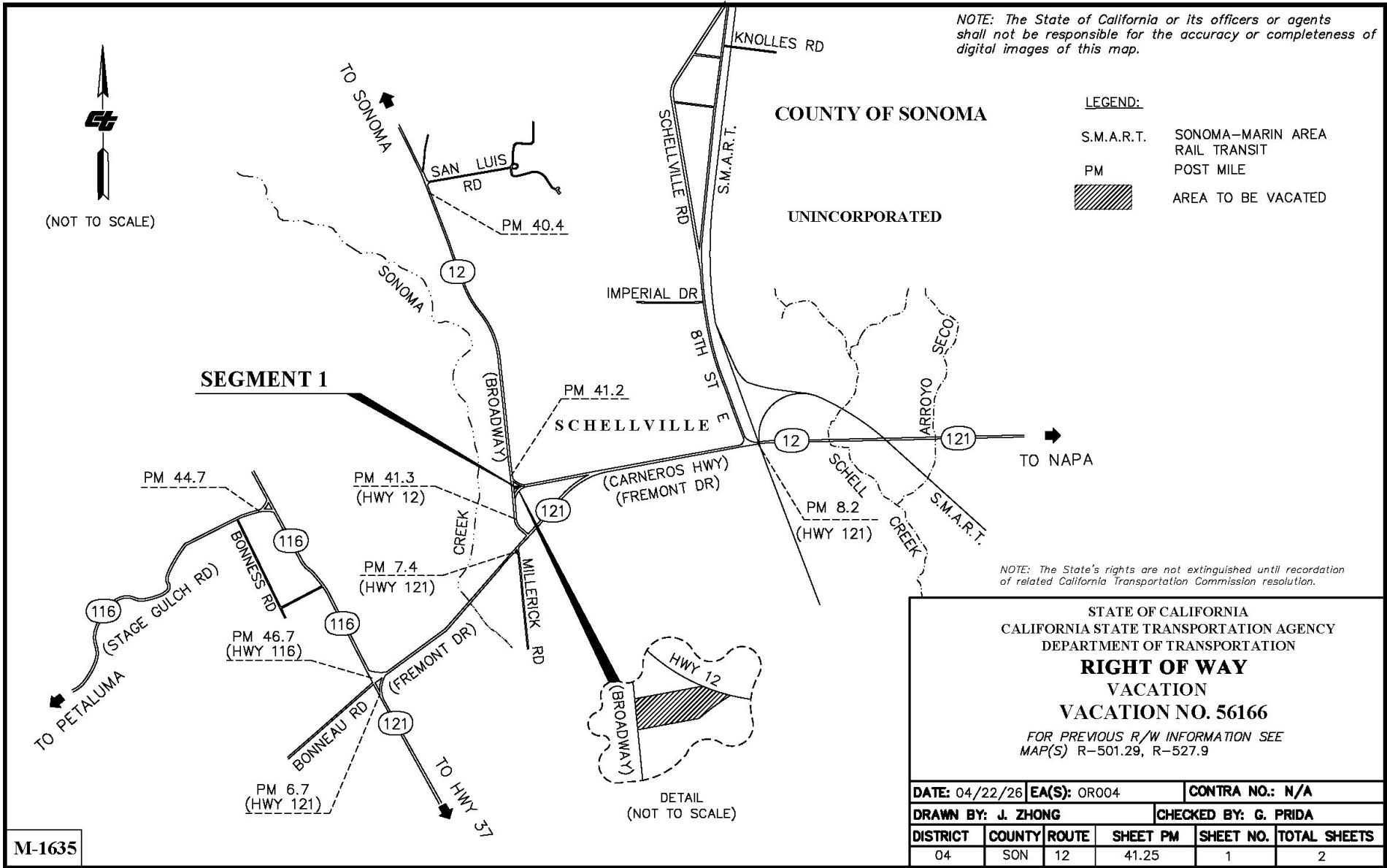
The Department recommends that the Commission approve the vacation resolution, summarized below. It has been determined by the Department that the facilities identified in the vacation resolution summarized below are not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by vacation. Upon the recording of the approved vacation resolution in the county where the facilities are located, the public's right to use the facilities will be abandoned. The vacation complies with Sections 892, 8313, and 8330.5 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summary.

RESOLUTION:

Resolution A-921 – 04-Son-12-PM 41.25
(Request No. V56166) – 1 Segment

Vacates right of way in the county of Sonoma (County) along State Route 12 near the intersection of Broadway and Fremont Drive, consisting of highway right of way no longer needed for State highway purposes. The County, by letter dated April 8, 2026, declined acceptance of relinquishment and does not protest this vacation. See Attachment 1A and 1B for the vacation location.
