## **SUMMARY:**

The Inspector General will provide an update from the Independent Office of Audits and Investigations (IOAI) as a discussion item at the California Transportation Commission's (Commission) June 2026 meeting. This update will include highlights from IOAI's "Annual Summary of Findings and Recommendations."

## **BACKGROUND:**

Government Code Section 14460(d)(2) requires IOAI to provide a summary report of investigation and audit findings and recommendations at least annually to the Governor, the Legislature, and the Commission. We provided the "Annual Summary of Findings and Recommendations" report for the period July 1, 2024, to June 30, 2025, to the Commission in March 2026.

## **DISCUSSION:**

During this reporting period, IOAI published 10 audits and special reports and performed over 213 reviews, resulting in 55 recommendations intended to promote performance improvements and increased accountability and transparency. The financial impact of these audits and reviews could potentially be as much as \$13.8 million.
