Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTION**

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the California Department of Transportation's (Department) request for a relinquishment resolution that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary for continued transportation purposes?

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the Commission approve the relinquishment resolution, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary for continued transportation purposes. It has been determined by the Department that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolution summarized below may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolution in the county where the facilities are located, all rights, title, and interest of the State in and to the facilities to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agency identified in the summary. The facilities are safe and drivable. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishment a minimum of 90 days before the Commission meeting pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summary.

RESOLUTION:

Resolution R-4129 – 07-LA-107-PM 0.0/4.8
(Request No. 1239) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Torrance along State Route 107 (Hawthorne Boulevard) between State Route 1 (Pacific Coast Highway) to the southerly city limits of Lawndale at Redondo Beach Boulevard, under the terms and conditions as stated in the relinquishment agreement dated July 16, 2026, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 639, Statutes of 2008, which amended Section 407.5 of the Streets and Highways Code. See Attachment 1 for the relinquishment location.

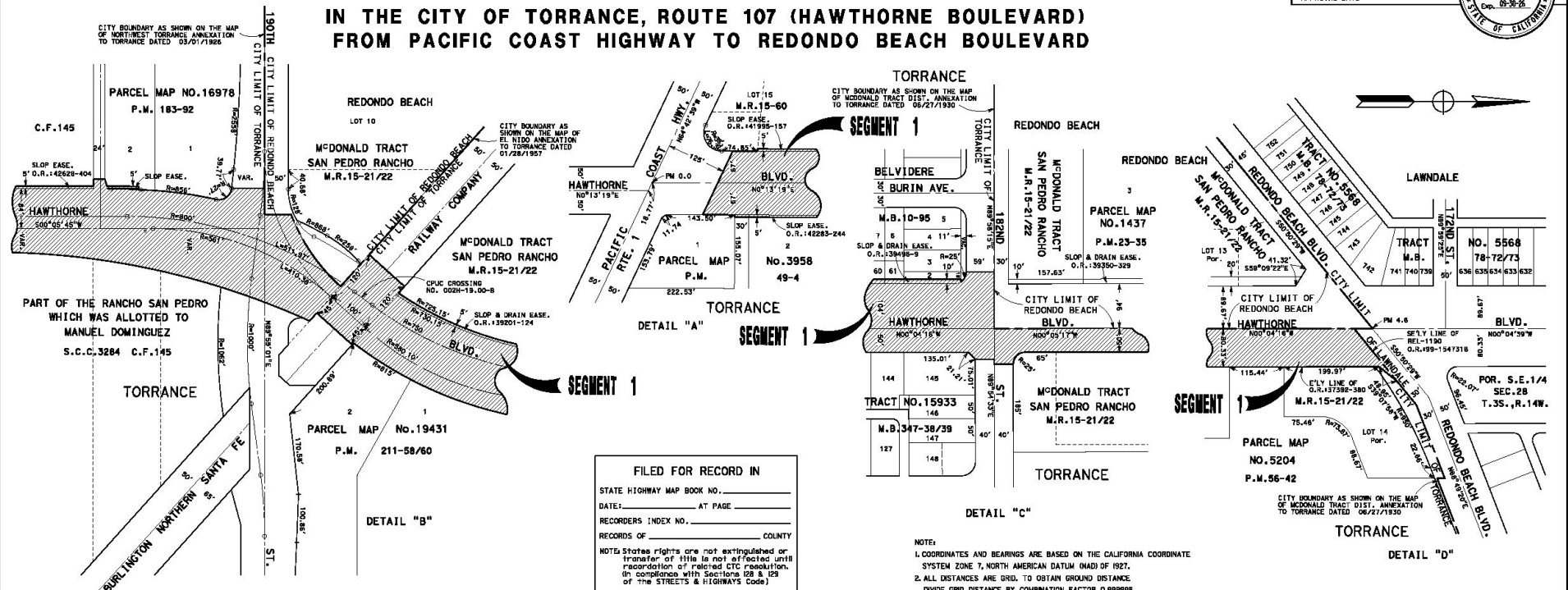

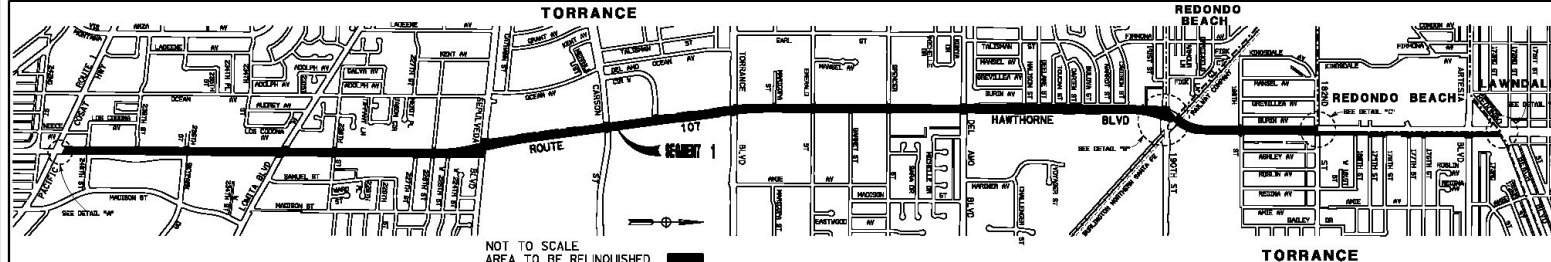
