Action Items

1. Discuss the Large application threshold, increasing it from the current \$7 million.
2. CTC staff to modify the first sentence of proposed Housing language to mirror anti-displacement language currently in the application.
3. CTC staff to look into electronic applications and the ADA requirements for the attachments.
4. CTC staff to work with Caltrans IT on electronic application submissions to ensure all bugs are addressed prior to application deadline.
5. CTC staff to work with SCAG to discuss their Quick-Build project process in plans.
6. CTC staff to look into DAC Free and Reduced Lunches Program since some are offering free lunches to all students as a result of the pandemic.
7. CTC staff to confirm the Version 4.0 CalEnviroScreen, the American Fact Finder and Census data for the DAC question.
8. Discuss Complete Streets SHOPP and LPP Formulaic funds as eligible leveraging options.
9. CTC staff to look into other acceptable forms of “skin in the game” that doesn’t rely on funds that a community may not have.
10. CTC staff to coordinate a Technical Advisory Committee for the Quick-Build Project Pilot Program – Phase II.
