Directions from Sacramento International Airport (SMF):

- Transit: <u>SacRT's Route 142</u> runs an express bus service from the airport to downtown Sacramento. The airport express shuttle bus runs every 20/30 minutes from Terminals A & B.
- When using ride share transportation services, there are specific designated areas for pick-up. Pick-up area is based on the Terminal.
- Sacramento International Airport (SMF) to Workshop Location:
 - Get on I-5 S from Airport Blvd
 - Follow I-5 S to Q St in Sacramento
 - Take exit 519A for Q Street from I-5 S
 - o Continue on Q St. Drive to 12th St
 - o Left on 12th St. Drive to O St.
 - o Right onto O St. Clifford L. Allenby Building will be on the left

 Transit: From Sacramento Valley Station, take SacRT's light rail Gold Line train to Archives Plaza Station (intersection of 11th St and O St). Walk one block to the west. The Clifford L. Allenby Building will be on the left.
