Planning for 2024: Expanded Leadership Structure and Subcommittees

- Charter adoption included continued discussion about the inclusion of an expanded leadership model
 - Expanded model = One Chair and multiple Vice Chairs (usually three to five)
 - Vice Chairs generally take on responsibilities as directed by the Charter, Chair, and/or Committee membership at large.

- Charter includes framework for creating subcommittees that will focus on various aspects of EAC engagement opportunities and administrative duties.
- Subcommittees can add focus and capacity for future workload responsibilities.

If the EAC agrees to pursue an expanded leadership structure, members may develop a proposal for adoption in early 2024.

Next Steps

Staff efforts to integrate Committee feedback:

- Staff will work with Committee members to ensure a clear understanding of their capacity and time commitments.
- Staff will present a draft calendar of Committee meetings for 2024.
- Staff will coordinate among agencies to limit time consuming activities that are less impactful.

Opportunities to collaborate with Committee leadership:

- Improved geographic and community-based outreach
- Engagement and learning with regional planning and transportation authorities
- Develop learning opportunities for understanding transportation planning and funding at the regional, state, and federal levels

- New member recommendations adopted at March CTC meeting

PROCESS:

- Interagency staff recommend nominees
- Interagency staff bring recommendations to CalSTA, Caltrans, and CTC for deliberation and decision
- Geography and demographics of new members are a priority for selection
- Efforts will be made to include greater representation from tribal groups and people with disabilities (among others)
