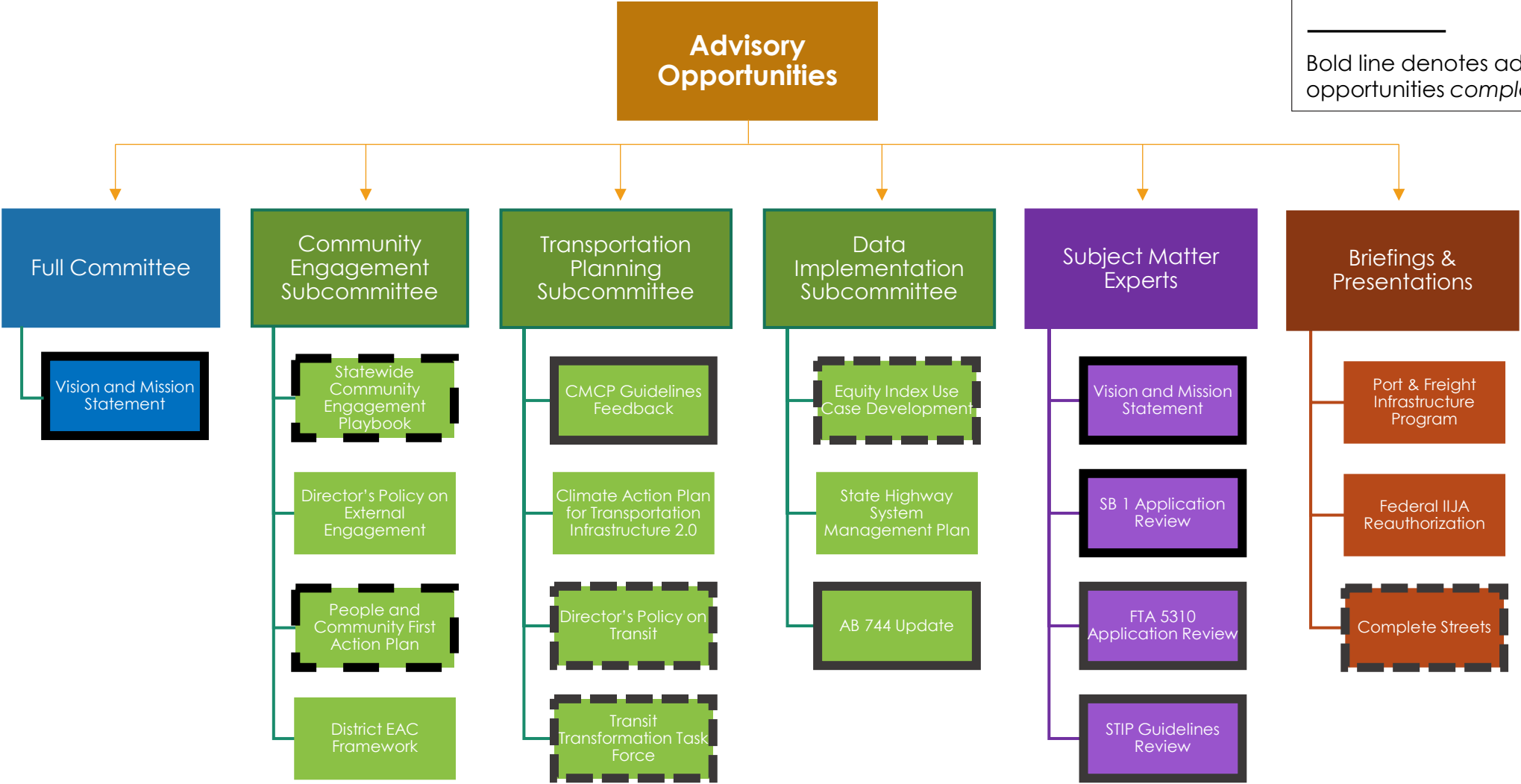

 - Will be incorporated into final 2026 document
 - Commission Senate Bill 1 Funding Program Updates
 - Report back on experiences from EAC reviewers; members felt empowered to evaluate honestly, need to ensure applications are remediated for ADA
 - EAC will be sought as Subject Matter Experts to develop updates to 2026 SB 1 Guidelines Equity Supplement
 - Caltrans Guidance for Engaging with Disability Communities
 - Discussion and resource development, will influence statewide disability engagement guidance
