




2026 Advisory Opportunities: Jan-Mar


2026 Advisory Opportunities: Apr-Jun


2026 Advisory Opportunities: Jul-Sep

2026 Advisory Opportunities: Oct-Dec





Where did influence feel limited or unclear?


- Outcomes/impacts of funding input
- Impacts on transportation policies and programs
 - Safety and climate
- A lot of information with limited turnaround times

45% felt their input had significant influence



2025 Committee Year End Survey

64% understood how input was used in advisory process



Suggestions for improvement:

- Consistently update members on status of advisory opportunities and the outcomes/impacts
- Better time-management during meetings
- Better accessibility, including real-time interpretation and visual supports



Committee Member Participation

- Members of the Committee play a vital role in advising California's transportation agencies throughout the year. The effectiveness of the Committee depends on members' active participation, thoughtful input, and ongoing engagement across multiple touchpoints.
- In addition to full Committee meetings, staff offer several opportunities for members to stay engaged, including pre-meeting briefings, post-meeting debriefs, subcommittees, and subject-matter expert roles. These options provide meaningful additional ways for members with the availability to participate more fully.
- Interagency Lead Staff will continue to offer touchpoints that are designed to ensure members feel prepared and supported in their advisory capacity, and to help the transportation agencies fully benefit from members' expertise and perspectives.
