- Required long-range (20-year) plan
- Updated every 5 years
- Must meet various federal and state requirements
- Guides high-level transportation planning
- Includes recommendations

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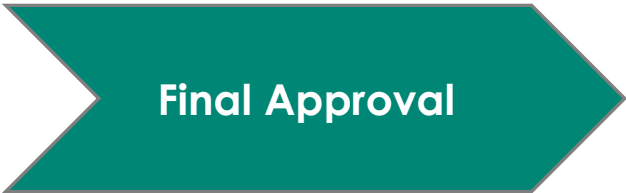

Key Messages

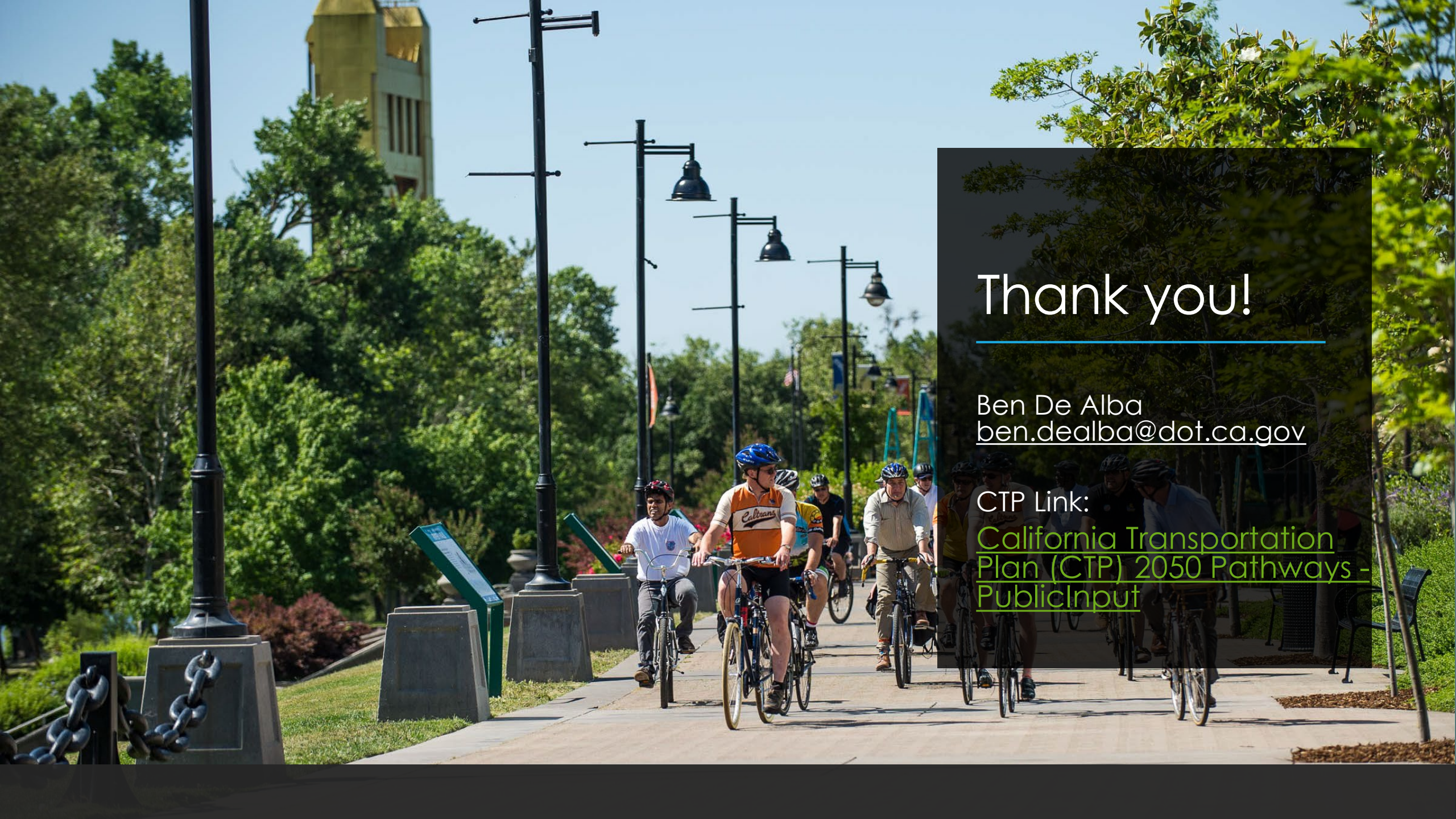
- Updated data
