

2023 Active Transportation Program

Kick-Off Workshop

November 9, 2021

Action Items

1. CTC staff to ask Active Transportation Resource Center (ATRC) staff to present on technical assistance opportunities at a future workshop.
2. CTC staff to work with stakeholders from the Rural Counties Task Force to discuss transformative projects and the challenges faced with funding simple walking and biking projects (i.e., sidewalks and bike lanes) at a future workshop.
3. Work group to discuss potential eligible plan types that would meet the criteria for a project being included in an active transportation plan. Potential plan types discussed at the November 9 workshop include:
 - a. Local Roadway Safety Plans
 - b. Campus/Community Long Range Plans
 - c. Vision Zero Plans
4. CTC staff to look into the Housing and Transportation Affordability Index and the TCAC/HCD Opportunity Map for potential future use as Disadvantaged Communities (DAC) qualifiers.
5. Work group to discuss connection between State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) Complete Streets projects and ATP projects.
6. Work group to discuss the possibility of down-scoping projects between Statewide and Small Urban & Rural Components at a future workshop.
7. CTC staff to conduct an analysis of standalone Non-Infrastructure Project submission over the cycles.
8. CTC staff to clarify application hard copy requirements and electronic submissions at a future workshop.
9. Work group to discuss inclusion of local ordinances in Transformative Projects question at a future workshop.

1. Finalized 2023 Active Transportation Program schedule.
2. Finalized Housing language in 2023 Active Transportation Program Guidelines.
