PROJECT SUMMARY

The San Andreas Pope Street and Safe Routes to School Project will construct a multi-use asphalt pathway along Main Street, Pope Street, Lewis Ave, California Street, Treat Avenue, and Nielson Road, along with high visibility crosswalks and intersection speed tables throughout the project area.

The project will provide safe bicycle and pedestrian connections through the main central residential neighborhood in San Andreas and to the major destinations in town such as the San Andreas Elementary School, Calaveras High School, Main Street shops, Mark Twain Hospital and Medical Center, Calaveras Health and Human Services, DMV, County Central Library, and the Calaveras County Government Center.
