Action Items

1. Clarify language pertaining “construction completion” in the Policy on User Counts section of the 2027 ATP Guidelines.
2. Consider raising the funding cap for Small Infrastructure projects. Further discussion in the 2029 ATP (Cycle 9).
3. Post track changes version of the ATP application alongside the workshop materials from the 01/14/26 ATP Central Workshop.
4. Post the draft Count Methodology Guidance with the 01/14/26 ATP Central Workshop materials.
5. CTC staff will increase the word count by 100 words for application questions with expanded language regarding active transportation users.
6. CTC staff will ensure application prompts on combination projects include the non-infrastructure component.
7. CTC staff will continue to work with Caltrans to get more information on reimbursement for the 5-year count requirements. Further discussion in the 2029 ATP (Cycle 9).
8. Caltrans to provide guidance on the PPR regarding notice to proceed and federal timelines.
