BAY SKYWAY PHASE 1



The Bay Area Toll Authority (BATA), in partnership with implementing agencies the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) and the San Francisco County Transportation Authority (SFCTA), is requesting \$25 million in Local Partnership Program (LPP) funds to construct Bay Skyway Phase 1. The project will create a walking, cycling, e-bike, and electric ferry connection while reducing congestion on the Bay Area's most congested corridor, the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge. Bay Skyways Phase 1 comprises three components that together will provide a seamless Transbay active transportation network, connect housing to jobs for disadvantaged and low-income residents, and support climate change goals by reducing greenhouse gas emissions.

BAY SKYWAY PHASE 1 will:

- » Increase Access to economic opportunities for residents of disadvantaged communities on both sides of the Bay
- » Reduce congestion in the Bay Area's most congested corridor
- » Improve safety for drivers and active transportation users throughout the corridor
- » Decrease greenhouse gas emissions for communities at high risk throughout the corridor
- » Add capacity to the Bay Bridge corridor while creating a new low-cost transportation option
