



## PROJECT FACT SHEET



### HILLSIDE BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PHASE II

**Estimated Construction Cost: \$9,100,000**

**Requested Fund: \$4,550,000**

**Local Match: \$4,550,000**

#### PROJECT SCOPE

The project will implement improvements on Hillside Blvd from Serramonte Blvd North to Lawndale Blvd South to transform this corridor into a traffic calmed, friendly environment to accommodate all modes of transportation and enhance safety and mobility of all road users. The major proposed improvements for complete street project and green street infrastructure include but not limited to:

- Installation of new sidewalks with new pedestrian lightings and signage.
- Installation of Class IV bicycle lanes with buffer to upgrade the existing Class II bike lane.
- Reconstruction of intersection at Lawndale Blvd with traffic signal modification, bulb-out curb extension, upgrade ADA curb ramps and pedestrian crosswalk with new countdown signal head, new separated bike crossing and new wayfinding.
- Improvement of existing crosswalks and install new pedestrian high visibility mid-block crosswalks, new curb extension and ADA curb ramps, advance stop bar and solar Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB).
- Pavement rehabilitation from edge to edge with dig-out repair and 2" asphalt pavement cold plane and overlay.
- Installation of green streets infrastructure improvement (rain garden) and landscaping features.
