

LIMONITE GAP CLOSURE PROJECT

Applicant: Western Riverside Council of Governments
 Implementing Agency: City of Eastvale



SCOPE

The Limonite Gap Closure Project will extend Limonite Avenue from its current terminus at Archibald Avenue to Hellman Avenue. The gap closure will construct a divided four-lane facility with 11-foot travel lanes. The project extends bicycle and pedestrian facilities with the construction of 12-foot Class 1 paths on both sides of the roadway. The project will also construct a 320-foot bridge over Cucamonga Creek Channel. A roundabout will be constructed at driveway entrances. The gap closure will provide a regional east-west connection from SR-71 to I-15.
