- The targets are percents that provide an indication of freight need in each region. The CTC considers (but does not have to abide by) these targets when awarding the 60% of regional TCEP funds.
- The targets were originally based on the 2007 Goods Movement Plan.
- We made a commitment in cycle 2 to update the information.
- We have about 6 months to work on these targets.
