

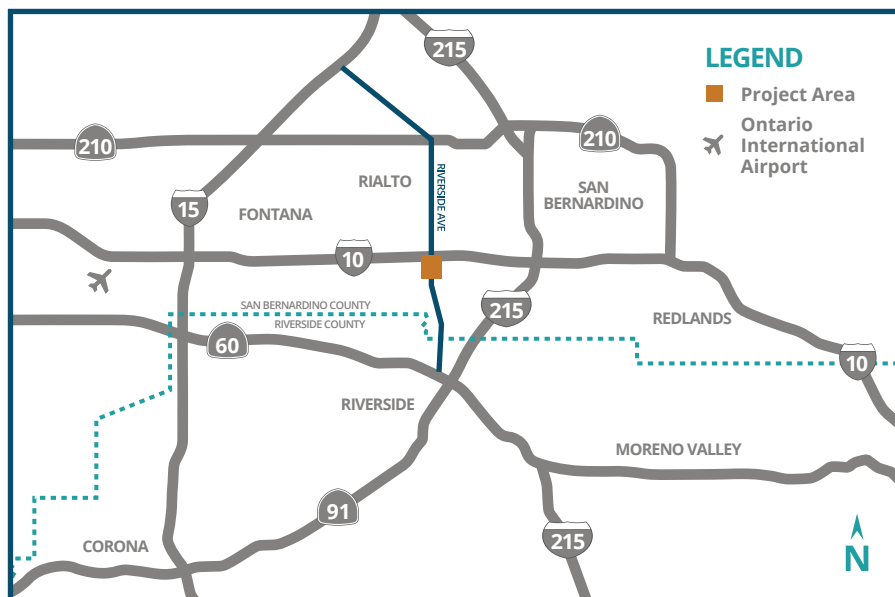
# B. FACT SHEET

## I/10 Riverside Ave Freight Improvement Project

### PROJECT SCOPE

The I/10 Riverside Ave Freight Improvement Project (Project) will improve traffic flow in a top 6 priority freight corridor by removing a major bottleneck for cars and trucks heading westbound on I-10 from Riverside Ave in Rialto. To achieve this goal, the Project will extend the existing two northbound left-turn lanes on the east side of Riverside Ave across the Union Pacific Railroad tracks so that the lane configuration of the southern section of the I-10/Riverside Ave intersection is consistent with the northern section. This improvement is anticipated to improve truck travel time by 17% and reduce idling. The Project will also fill a roughly 500 foot sidewalk gap to enhance pedestrian access and safety in the corridor.

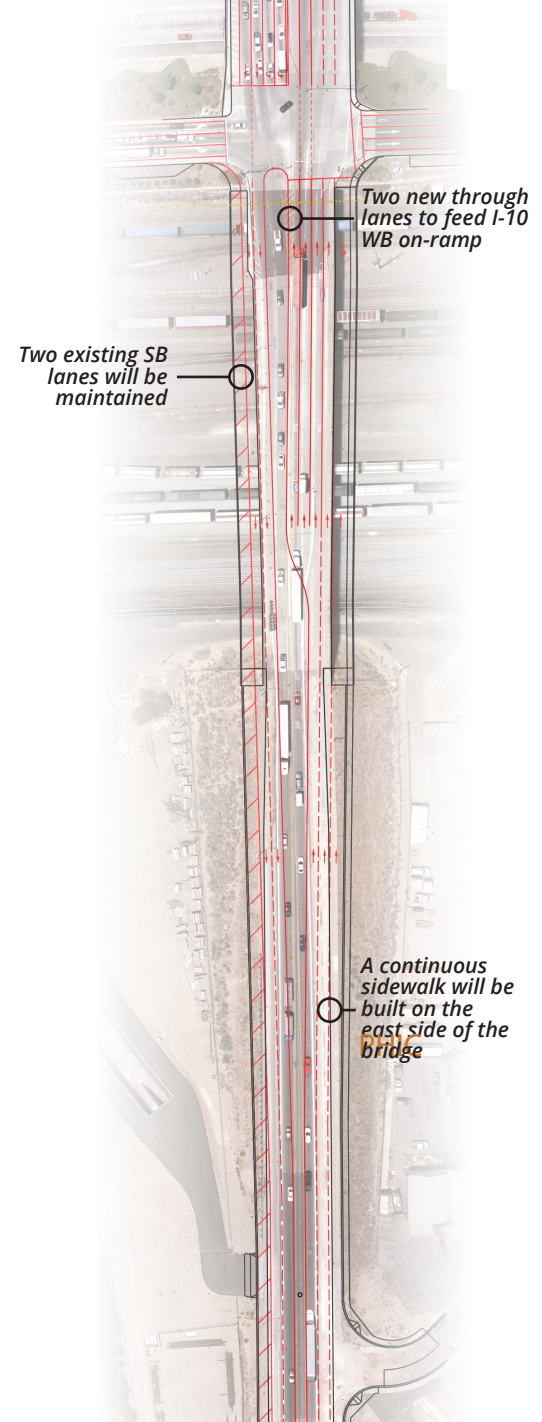
