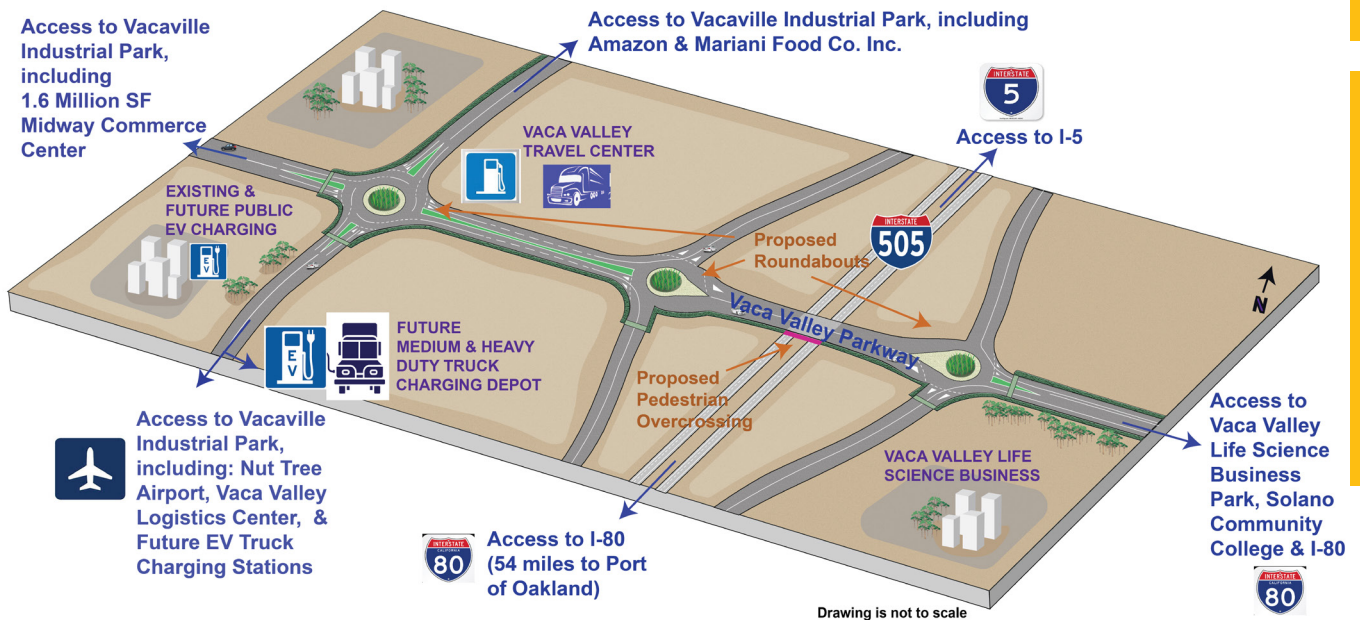


# VACA VALLEY PARKWAY/I-505

## MULTIMODAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT



### Current Conditions

- Significant number of collisions
- No pedestrian/bike facilities
- Narrow bridge over I-505
- Inadequate turning capacity
- Poor truck access
- Peak travel delays



### Project Scope

- Improvements begin just west of the East Monte Vista Avenue/Crocker Drive intersection and extend to just east of the I-505 northbound on/off ramps.
- The project would replace two signalized intersections and one stop-controlled intersection with roundabouts to improve safety, freight movement, and overall traffic operations.
- A new bicycle/pedestrian overcrossing will be constructed just south of Vaca Valley Parkway, completing a gap in the active transportation network.

### Project Benefits

- Connected roundabouts implement a safe systems approach for all roadway users, promoting Vision Zero goals
- Accommodates trucks and facilitates increased freight movement from the nearby industrial, manufacturing, and logistics hub
- Provides improved access to a future Truck EV Charging Depot
- New separated bike/ped facility connects communities across I-505 and facilitates active transportation
- Eliminates need for costly bridge widening and seismic retrofit
- Reduces pollution with Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emission reductions
- Supports economic development by encouraging freight movement, infill development and job growth

- 3 enhanced crossings
- 3 shorted crossings
- 657-foot sidewalk reconstruction
