Road Repairs and Accountability Act of 2017 Established on Advance Mitigation Program



- ☐ Streets and Highways Code Division 1, Chapter 4, Article 2.5
- ☐ Per SHC 800 et seq., the AMP seeks to achieve the following:
 - Support the acceleration of transportation project delivery
 - Protect natural resources through transportation project mitigation and to mitigate, to the maximum extent required by law, environmental impacts from future transportation infrastructure projects
- Enhance communication with stakeholders and CDFW
- Provide successful mitigation that meets or exceeds applicable environmental requirements that contribute to natural resource protection and enhancement

Transportation projects still program mitigation costs as typical


If Advance Mitigation Credit/Value is available Transportation project may purchase from Advance Mitigation Program
