### Subject: STATUS OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT AWARD FOR STATE HIGHWAY PROJECTS

### **SUMMARY:**

The California Department of Transportation is presenting this item to provide the status of construction contract award for projects on the State Highway System allocated in Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-17 and FY 2017-18.

In FY 2016-17, the California Transportation Commission (Commission) voted 524 State-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP), and Proposition 1B projects on the State Highway System. As of December 28, 2017, 509 projects totaling \$1.526 billion have been awarded. Funds for one project have lapsed.

In FY 2017-18, the California Transportation Commission (Commission) voted 186 State-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP), and Proposition 1B projects on the State Highway System. As of December 28, 2017, 102 projects totaling \$238.969 million have been awarded.

### **BACKGROUND:**

Starting with July 2006 allocations, projects are subject to Resolution G-06-08, which formalizes the condition of allocation that requires projects to be ready to proceed to construction within six months of allocation. The policy also requires that projects that are not awarded within four months of allocation be reported to the Commission.
